## **ABOUT THE CLASSES OFFERED IN CHARLOTTE, North Carolina**

### **Digitizing Software Class: Stitch & Sew Digitizing Software**

**Thursday 9:30am to 5:00pm** (with 12:00pm-1:30pm break)

Instruction on the operation of Stitch & Sew Digitizing & Editing software to create custom embroidery designs with lettering and digitizing tools, and learning how to control sewing quality on various types of garments. (note: topic schedules are approximate)

- Morning Session Topics (9:30 to 12:00)
  - Introduction to Embroidery Theory & Stitch Quality
  - Key boundaries: 1mm (.04inch) and 10mm (0.4inch)
  - Introduction to Stitch & Sew program
  - Lettering (basics, then common commercial lettering jobs)
  - Optimizing output for your embroidery machine (sewing efficiency, quality)
  - Adjusting for different types of fabrics
- Afternoon Session Topics (1:30 to 5:00pm)
  - More on embroidery settings/adjustments
  - Advanced lettering /
  - Digitizing tools: freeform
  - Preparing digitizing jobs
  - Digitizing logos

### **Happy Single-Head Embroidery Machines: HCD-1501 (and HCS Voyager)**

**Friday 9:30am to 5:00pm** (with 12:00pm-1:30pm break)

Instruction on proper setup, operation, troubleshooting and maintenance of your HAPPY 1-head machine. Principal product is HAPPY HCD-1501. Those HCS-1201 Voyager (color monitor version) is also taught, as both machines have nearly identical controls.

(note: topic schedules are approximate)

- Morning Session Topics (9:30 to 12:00)
  - Embroidery Machines Intro/ (needles, thread, machine basics)
  - Introduction to Control Panel: Basic Operations, Setting design colors and hoop fit
  - Basic Threading and Tension
  - Hooping basics
  - Techniques for different garments: backing, topping, needles, etc.
  - Commercial embroidery basics (efficiency, digitizing, designs, etc)
- Afternoon Session Topics (1:30 to 5:00pm)
  - More on embroidery settings/adjustments
  - Basic Upkeep/Maintenance: Oiling and Cleaning
  - Maintenance/Adjustment procedures: troubleshooting, needles, timing, needle bar, presser foot depth
  - Firmware Updates & Other Machine updates

  - Embroidery Business: pricing/costing, production basics, sourcing, marketing
  - Sewing on finished ballcaps
  - Additional hooping techniques / devices (Hoopmaster / clamps / alternate hoops)
