Advanced Machine Class: More in-depth operation, maintenance, repair of Happy 1-Head embroidery machines (including HCH, HCS, and HCD model lines)

9:30am to 5:00pm (with 12:00pm-1:30pm break)

Note: Class members are encouraged but not required to bring their own laptops (if practical) to take better advantage of some learning tools. *Topic schedule is approximate and may change.*
