Advanced Machine Class: More in-depth operation, maintenance, repair of Happy 1-Head embroidery machines (including HCH, HCS, and HCD model lines)

Advanced Digitizing: Professional Quality Digitizing & Advanced Editing with Stitch & Sew2

 - "Pro"-level digitizing: additional techniques to maximize quality & sew-ability
 - Digitizing workshop: digitizing actual logos chosen in-class
 - **Advanced Editing**
 - Editing as you Digitize
 - Additional editing: improving existing designs, combining designs, common fixes
 - **Review** of progress before lunch break

 - **"Bettering the Art" of digitizing**

 - Use of color: better color selection, gradients
 - **Follow up Digitizing Practice**

Advanced Digitizing Pre-Requisite

The focused content of this class assumes that students have some prior knowledge of their digitizing software (covered in the Basic Digitizing class also offered by TEXMAC) to maximize the benefits from this class.
