DAY 1: BASIC LEVEL MACHINE TRAINING Happy 1-Head Embroidery Machines

Monday, January 23, 9:30am to 5:00pm (with 12:00pm-1:30pm break)

For both touch screen and color screen Voyagers and HCD's, Happy 7-needle Journey Setup, operation, and maintenance of your HAPPY 1-head machine.

Note: Topic schedule is approximate.

- Morning Session Topics (9:30 to 12:00)
 - o Embroidery Machines Intro/ (needles, thread, machine basics)
 - o Introduction to Control Panel: Basic Operations, Setting design colors and hoop fit
 - o Basic Threading and Tension
 - Hooping basics
 - o Techniques for different garments: backing, topping, needles, etc.
 - o Commercial embroidery basics (efficiency, digitizing, designs, etc)
- Afternoon Session Topics (1:30 to 5:00pm)
 - o More on embroidery settings/adjustments
 - Basic Upkeep/Maintenance: Oilling and Cleaning
 - o Maintenance/Adjustment procedures: troubleshooting, needles, timing, needle bar, presser foot depth
 - Firmware Updates & Other Machine updates
- Additional/Optional Topics (based on class requests / available time, etc)
 - o Embroidery Business: pricing/costing, production basics, sourcing, marketing
 - Sewing on finished ballcaps
 - Additional hooping techniques / devices (Hoopmaster / clamps / alternate hoops)

 - Understanding the stitch cycle/embroidery process more thoroughly
 - Advanced Features: taking advantage of additional features in your HAPPY machine.
 - o Taking Your Work to the Next Level: Upping Sewing Quality Across the Board
 - Understanding how digitizing quality affects sewing quality (from a non-digitizer's standpoint)
 - Advanced Setup: making better choices on hooping, stabilizer, thread, needles
 - Machine Performance: Key adjustments that improve quality and productivity
 - Advanced Machine Maintenance
 - Basic maintenance review, more thorough, long-term maintenance
 - Troubleshooting Your machine
- Afternoon Session Topics (1:30 to 5:00pm)
 - Advance Machine Maintenance (continued)
 - Repairs and adjustments
 - Trendy/Popular Projects covered in-depth. Sample try-it-yourself files, materials/sources given out in class.
 - Professional Applique (and the typical applique process)
 - Creating professional quality patches
 - Digitizing and Sewing 3-D foam designs on hats
 - Open Question-and-Answer Session

Note: Class members are encouraged to bring their own laptops if they can to take better advantage of some learning tools. Owners may also bring their own machines (at their own risk) if arrangements are made prior to class.





Procedures and Policies for Training Classes at TEXMAC Inc.

- Up to 2 persons per company may attend. Attendees must be at least 16 years of age, due to the operation of machinery in the classroom.
